County Receives \$891,070 in PARIS Grant Funding

The County officially received \$891,070 in Public Archives and Records Infrastructure Support (PARIS) grant funding at the regular meeting of the Board of Chosen Freeholders on Wednesday, July 18, 2007.

The grant will go toward the salaries and benefits of the archives office employees, staff training and fitting the new records center at the new county facility in Mannington Township.
